Do you feel lonely and isolated and need some support to build up your confidence? The Lets Get Out project aims to reduce loneliness and improve confidence by providing short term support to bring people together to establish friendships and share interests throughout Cardiff and the Vale of Glamorgan. We can share our knowledge of what is available in your community and encourage and support you to become more involved. Perhaps there is a group or class you would like to join or you may want someone to walk with you to the local shop or visit friends until you have gained confidence. Advocacy Service (Cardiff & Vale of Glamorgan)

Do you live in a care home and need help solving a problem? Our Advocates provide a free and independent service which identifies with and represents a person's views and concerns. It emphasises empowerment, enabling people to solve their own problems. This help has also been extended to people who live at home in the Vale of Glamorgan. If you need our support we can help individuals to write letters, make phone calls, or represent their wishes, and or negotiate with outside agencies. Hospital Discharge Service (Cardiff & Vale of Glamorgan)

If you or an older person you know is discharged from hospital you could make contact with our Hospital Discharge Service. The service provides short term, flexible support for older people on discharge from hospital. Our experienced Settlement Aides make home visits and can provide practical support such as assist with personal care if required, prepare a meal, do a small shop, provide information and support and will contact other services on behalf of the older person. The Service is registered as a domiciliary care agency with the Care and Social Services Inspectorate Wales (CSSIW). For more information phone: 029 2068 3693.

Safeguarding Programme

Do you know someone with dementia that may need someone to speak up for them? Our Safeguarding Project works specifically with older people who have a dementia it provides both instructed and non-instructed advocacy. The project employs a variety of advocacy

approaches and communication tools as required. The South East Wales Safeguarding Older People programme is a partnership of 4 local organisations, coordinating provision of independent advocacy to vulnerable and isolated older people. Funded by the BIG Lottery Fund, in Cardiff and the Vale of Glamorgan the Safeguarding Project supports older people with a dementia who are living in a care home setting.
